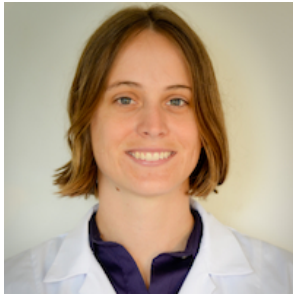


WFDF Board of Directors Elections (2016-2017 term)

**Candidate Statement Jamie Nuwer**



I have attended WFDF world championship events since 2006 as a player and then as a coach. In 2011 I began assisting WFDF as a medical committee chairwoman. I am interested in this position in order to improve the player experience and the medical care provided at these events.

I have competed in the women's, mixed and women's masters divisions at WUCC and WUGC. I have served as the USA doctor/trainer at WJUC 2010 and 2014. I coached USA girls at WJUC 2012 and USA mixed at WJUC 2013.

At USA Ultimate I have served as a medical advisor since 2005. I created and have chaired the USA Ultimate medical committee since around 2010. Together we have made several important improvements in terms of medical staffing at events, heat-related event cancellation policies, transgender athlete policies, and anti-doping policies. We are currently working on a comprehensive concussion policy. At the WFDF medical committee we have been working on anti-doping education, testing and policy.

As I understand that the IOC is requesting that the chair of the Medical and Antidoping Committee be a WFDF Board member I happily have agreed to stand for re-election to such a position to further support WFDF-IOC cooperation.
