WFDF Elections 2016 – Candidate Statement

Having increased my involvement in 2001, including the many leadership roles referred to in the following section, I have led the resurgence of Guts Frisbee in the US. In 2001 there were 2 US tournaments which had shrunk to a precipitous level. The US had failed to attend WUGC events due to lack of US leadership. In recent years US tournaments, have grown to 6 major events and a couple of dozen smaller/local events.

We had struggled to recruit adequate numbers of Guts teams for WUGC and in the past that section of the event was run less professionally than the Ultimate portion. In 2016 as the TD for Guts in London we had 8 teams, representing 6 countries and staged probably the most professional Guts division at WUGC. To be sure I had quite a bit of help pulling off such a great event, but that is my primary strength. Successfully working with diverse groups of people to create the best scenario possible.
